In the evening, I relax by listening to music or watching series online. However, I always try to limit my screen time before going to bed because I know it can affect my sleep. If we use technology responsibly, we can enjoy its benefits without the negative effects. That is why I believe technology is one of the most powerful tools that students can have today.
